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**Item 1:** Call Meeting to Order – Chair Chapman called the meeting to order at 5:00pm.

The Board reviewed the minutes of March 1, 2022.

Selectman Jordan motioned and Selectman Milliard seconded to approve the minutes as submitted. Vote: 3-0. Minutes are approved.

**Item 6:** Discussion on MMA Workplace Safety Program

Review and sign resolve.

Kim explained that MMA has started a new incentive program to offer a discount to participating Towns. Kim explained that MMA will assist participating Towns to implement programs and policies that will help reduce workplace injuries thus reducing claims.

The Board reviewed the Resolve and signed the document. Kim will send a copy to MMA Workers Comp and start working on implementing the program.

**Item 7:** Discussion on wearing mask indoor Town Facilities open to public

Kim asked the Board if they wanted to continue to require mask wearing in our public buildings as many places were lifting this requirement. Selectman Milliard asked Kim how she felt about this as they had made this requirement to protect her. Kim explained that she appreciated the Boards thoughtfulness on this but agreed that cases were on the decline and she was fine with not having the mask requirement. Chair Chapman stated that if the numbers start to rise again, the Board would be willing to revisit the issue.

**Item 8:** Discussion on Employee Health Insurance Renewal

The Board reviewed the Employee Health Insurance renewal documents from United Insurance. The Board agreed to renew with the suggested renewal plan of Anthem Silver Maine HMO Tiered Options. Selectman Milliard stated that this plan had a 7% increase. Kim stated that she was working with agent to determine that the new costs were for dependents so that she would update the employees on what that increase would be to their payroll deductions.

**Item 9:** Update on Aging Friendly Communities

Kim updated the Board that Aging Friendly Communities has three picnic tables to donate to the Town of Greenwood. She explained that they would like to have one of the tables on display at either our Town Meeting in May or at the Primary Election in June. Kim asked the Board if they had a preference. Chair Chapman stated that the Town Meeting would have about 40 people attending for a few hours and Election Day would have more people voting but it would be over a longer period. Kim explained that they were hoping to spend a few hours in each Town so Town Meeting would probably work best. Selectman Jordan asked if the tables would need to be tied down in some way so they couldn't be taken. Kim stated that they wondered the same and said they would leave that decision up to the Town. Selectman Milliard asked if we knew where the tables were going to be place. Kim explained that they wanted to put one at our Town Beach, Boat Launch, and at Maggie's Park. Kim stated that she would reach out to our representative, Bob Oickle to discuss having them attend our Town Meeting in May.
